Nothing in this 2006 Voter Guide should be construed as an endorsement of any candidate or as an attempt to influence the outcome of an electoral contest.

What’s inside?

Races included in this guide are U.S. Senate, U.S. House of Representatives, IN Secretary of State, IN Auditor of State, IN Treasurer of State, State Senate and State House of Representatives. Members of the U.S. House, State Senate and State House are elected by legislative district. U.S. Senate, IN Secretary of State, IN Auditor of State and IN Treasurer of State are on all Indiana ballots. For the first time, IFI mailed candidate questionnaires to judges, so that Hoosier voters would be more informed on election day. Unfortunately, very few judges chose to respond. Those who did respond are included, along with the contact information for candidates up for retention in the Indiana Supreme Court and Indiana Court of Appeals. Contact your county courthouse to find out which judges will be on your ballot on election day and how to get in touch with them.
