2019 LEGISLATIVE SCORECARD

Indiana Senate 2019 Legislative Session

1. ENDING THE PRACTICE OF DISMEMBERING LIVE BABIES

HB 1211 by Sen. Brown (R-15) and Rep. Mayfield (R-60) ends the practice of dismembering live babies during abortion procedures. This gruesome practice is used in many mid- and late-term abortions and involves dismembering the baby in the womb and removing it piece by piece. The aborted baby must be reassembled afterwards to ensure that no part of the baby is left inside the mother. **IFI Supported.** Yes (✓) = 38 | No (X) = 10 | Excused (E) = 2 | Not Voting (NV) = 0 |
Status: Signed by Governor.

2. CREATES A FUND TO PROTECT CHILDREN FROM INTERNET CRIMES

SB 3 by Sen. Crider (R-28) and Rep. Frye (R-67) establishes a fund to help law enforcement focus on defending children from internet crimes, such as those that might be perpetrated by internet predators, sex predators, and human traffickers. **IFI Supported.** Yes (✓) = 47 | No (X) = 0 | Excused (E) = 2 | Not Voting (NV) = 1 |
Status: Passed the Senate, but did not get through the House and died.

3. FRIENDLY AMENDMENT TO SB 12: HATE CRIMES BILL

Amendment #2 by Sen. Freeman (R-32) to SB 12 by Sen. Bohacek was added to remove troubling language that likely would have undermined religious liberty and free speech including special protected classes for "sexual orientation" and "gender identity". The underlying bill was filed to create new protected classes and would have established in statute that some groups of people were more deserving of justice than others. **IFI Supported the Amendment.** Yes (✓) = 33 | No (X) = 16 | Excused (E) = 1 | Not Voting (NV) = 0 |
Status: Amendment passed. This bill died, but hate crimes language (without the troubling list of protected classes) was amended into SB 198, passed both chambers and was signed by the Governor.

4. ENCOURAGING CIVICS EDUCATION IN INDIANA SCHOOLS

SB 132 by Sen. Kruse (R-14) and Rep. Burton (R-58) requires Indiana schools to administer the immigration and naturalization citizenship test to high school students. We believe that understanding our nation's history and our system of government is critical to a healthy electorate. **IFI Supported.** Yes (✓) = 31 | No (X) = 17 | Excused (E) = 2 | Not Voting (NV) = 0 |
Status: Signed by Governor.

5. PROTECTING CONSCIENCE RIGHTS FOR HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS

SB 201 by Sen. Brown (R-15) and Rep. Bacon (R-75) protects the rights of healthcare professionals such as nurses, pharmacists, and physicians' assistants from being required to participate in an abortion procedure if it conflicts with their rights of conscience. No healthcare worker should be forced into participating in an abortion procedure against his or her will. **IFI Supported.** Yes (✓) = 38 | No (X) = 8 | Excused (E) = 3 | Not Voting (NV) = 1 |
Status: Signed by Governor.

6. FAMILY CARE PORTAL

SB 365 by Sen. Zay (R-17) and Rep. Frizzell (R-93) provides that the Department of Child Services may collaborate with community based entities and programs designed to connect the department with supportive local community organizations including local churches and faith based organizations. This would allow local churches to help meet the needs of at-risk children and families to prevent the need for DCS to break up families. **IFI Supported.** Yes (✓) = 40 | No (X) = 0 | Excused (E) = 1 | Not Voting (NV) = 9 |
Status: Signed by Governor.

Indiana House of Representatives 2019 Legislative Session

1. HOSTILE AMENDMENT TO HB 1001: MANDATING GLBT CONFORMITY IN SCHOOLS

Amendment #41 by Rep. Forestal (D-100) to HB 1001, the State Education Budget, would have mandated that all schools (public, private and charter) support homosexuality and transgenderism. This amendment would have mandated that private Christian schools hire teachers who are openly violating biblical teaching. It would have forced all schools to allow biological males into girl's locker rooms and shower facilities as well as onto girl's sports teams. It would force Christian teachers, administrators and students to violate their conscience and promote ideas regarding human sexuality and gender that are at odds with the Bible. **IFI opposed the Amendment.** No (✓) = 62 | Yes (x) = 30 | Excused (E) = 4 | Not Voting (NV) = 4 |

Status: Amendment Failed.

Status: Signed by Governor.

4. PROTECTING CONSCIENCE RIGHTS FOR HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS

SB 201 by Sen. Brown (R-15) and Rep. Bacon (R-75) protects the rights of healthcare professionals such as nurses, pharmacists, and physicians' assistants from being required to participate in an abortion procedure if it conflicts with their sincerely held beliefs about life. No healthcare worker should be forced into participating in an abortion procedure against his or her will. **IFI Supported.** Yes (✓) = 69 | No (x) = 25 | Excused (E) = 5 | Not Voting (NV) = 1 |

Status: Signed by Governor.

5. FAMILY CARE PORTAL

SB 365 by Sen. Zay (R-17) and Rep. Frizzell (R-93) provides that the Department of Child Services may collaborate with community based entities and programs designed to connect the department with supportive local community organizations including local churches and faith based organizations. This would allow local churches to help meet the needs of at-risk children and families to prevent the need for DCS to break up families. **IFI Supported.** Yes (✓) = 94 | No (x) = 0 | Excused (E) = 5 | Not Voting (NV) = 1 |
